To meet their obligations under antidiscrimination law your school should:




respect your privacy and not out you



have equal policies for students in relationships around PDA and dates to school events



talk to you and about you respectfully and not use slurs or inappropriate language



not let students use the word "gay" as a slang term for anything bad



take bullying seriously and not let other students bully you
