antidiscrimination law your school should:



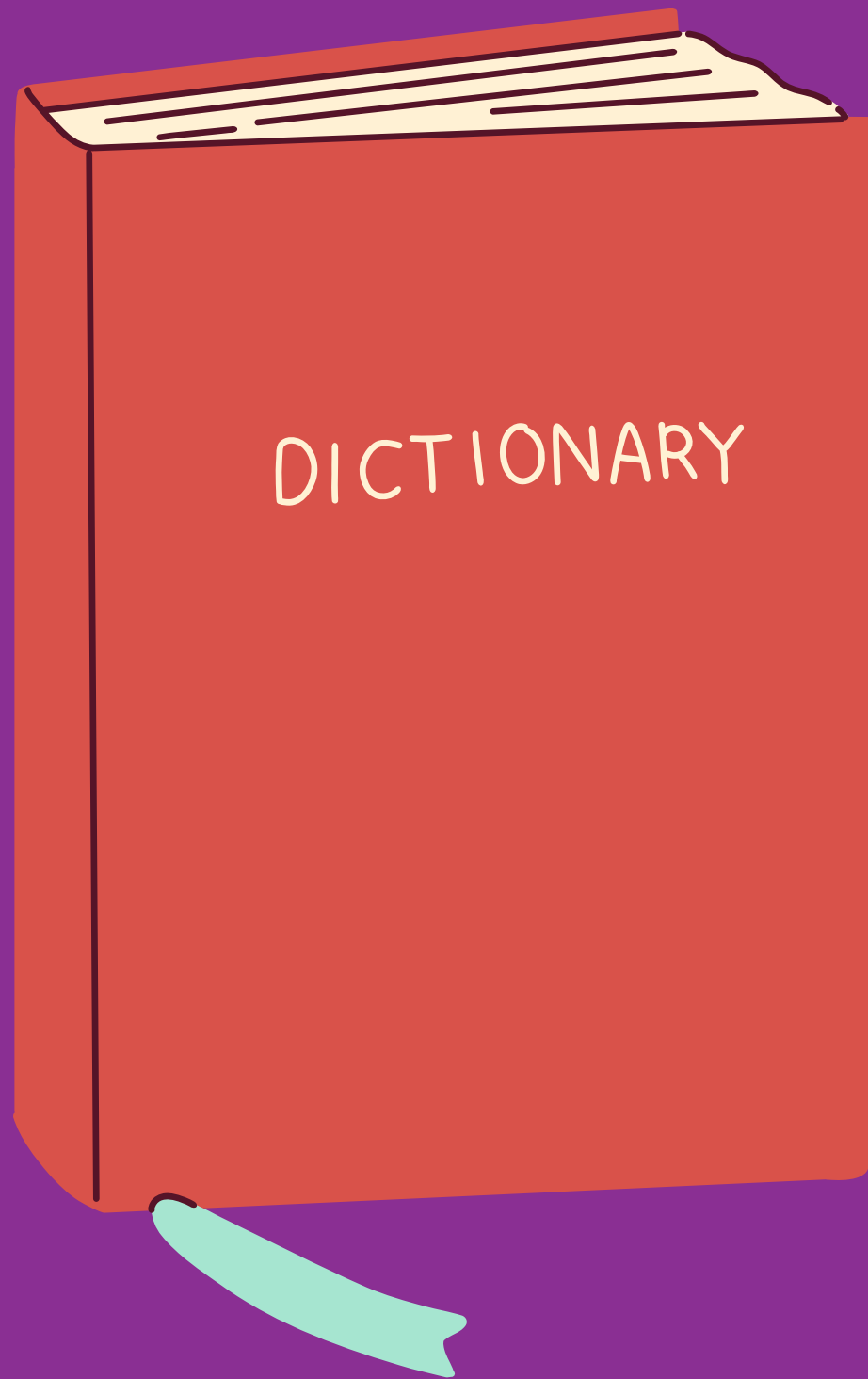
respect your privacy and not out you
